- ♪ Classical Era- The time period ranging from the late 18<sup>th</sup> to the early 19<sup>th</sup> centuries.
- ♪ Deaf- Partially or wholly lacking or deprived of the sense of hearing; unable to hear.
- ♪ Fur Elise- Is a famous solo piano piece written by Beethoven in April of 1810. This piece was written out of love for a special woman in Beethoven's life.
- ♪ German Composer- Beethoven was born in Bonn, Germany.
- ♪ Ludwig van Beethoven- A German composer and pianist. He bridged the classical and romantic eras.
- ♪ Ode To Joy- This is one of Beethoven's most popular works from his 9<sup>th</sup> Symphony. This was the first time ever, that a composer used voices in a symphony!
- ♪ Organ- A keyboard wind instrument consisting of one or more keyboards.
- ♪ Piano- A keyboard instrument on which sound is produced by hammers striking strings when keys are pressed. It has 88 keys!
- ♪ Romantic Era- The time period ranging from 1815 to 1910. Beethoven pioneered this era.
- ♪ Viola- Is the tenor violin. A bowed string instrument, which Beethoven played during his lifetime.
